This is better than last week!! Thank you for making the effort to get to school on time every day.

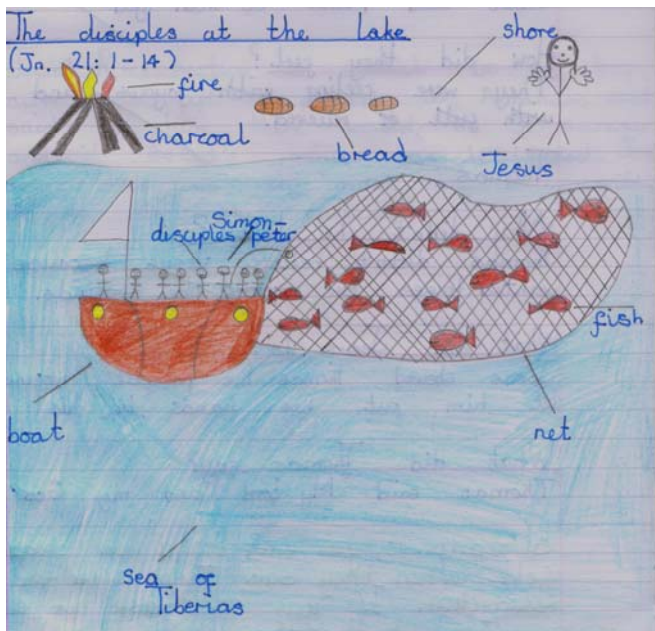


ATTENDANCE CHAMPIONS - Year 1
