Most of these are the same children who are just 5 minutes late - leave home a little earlier and BE ON TIME!

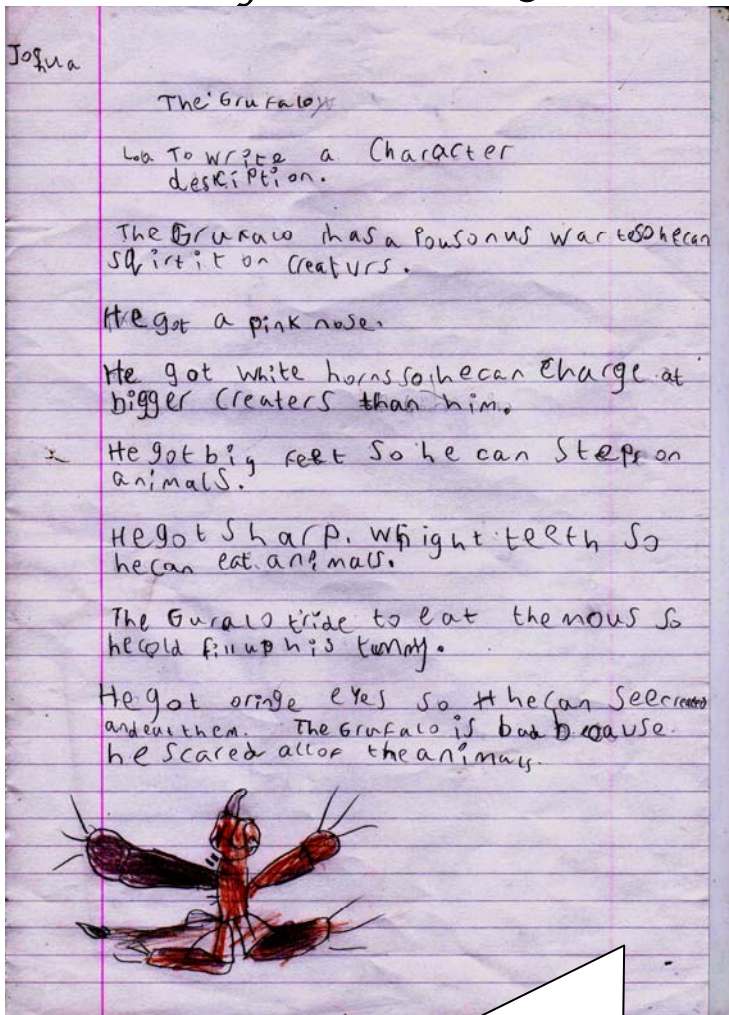
### ATTENDANCE CHAMPIONS - Year 6
