Another fabulous week, Yr 6. You are the first Y6 in history to have 100% attendance on the day following Min y Don!! Y2 were brilliant in KS1.

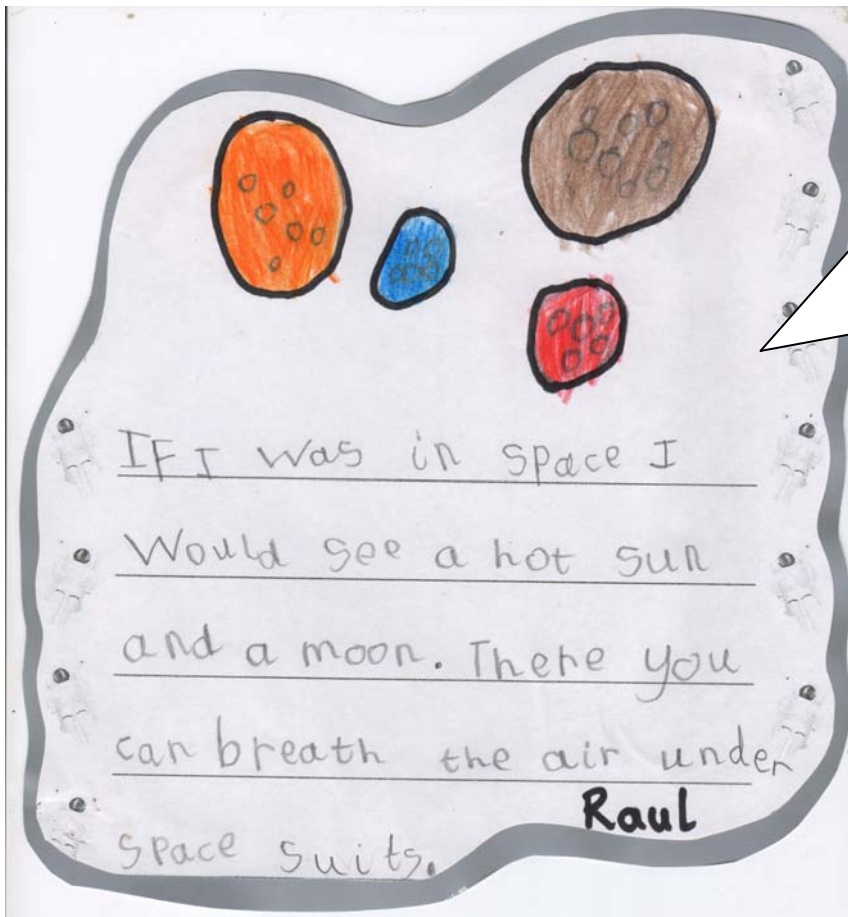
