Again, this proves that punctuality matters. The Attendance Champions are the class with the lowest combined score of missed days and late arrivals. Well done Year 6 - keep up the good work

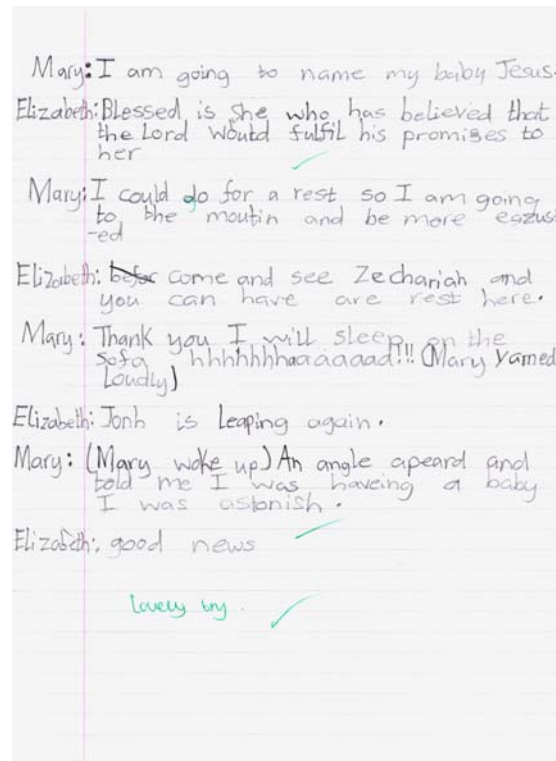
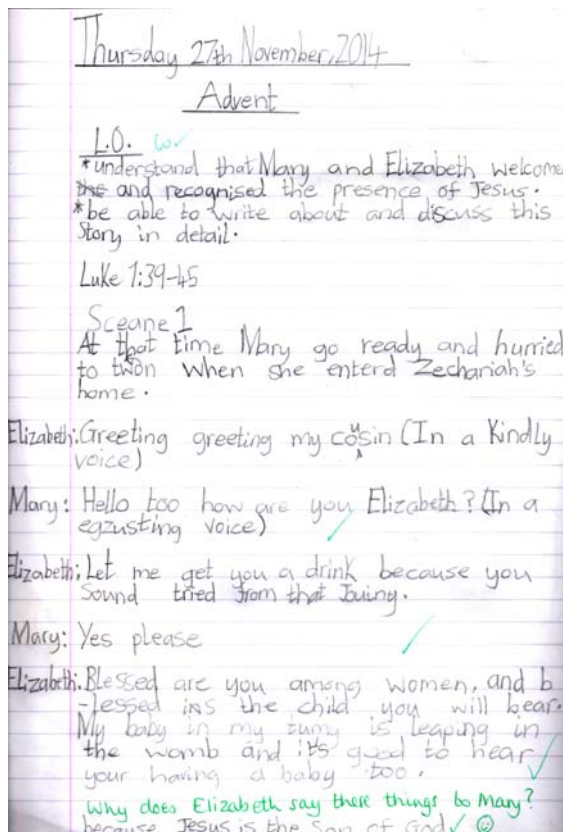
