Fact of the Week

Rec'n	You can count in 10s.
Year 1	There are ten 10s in 100.
Year 2	To find $\frac{3}{4}$ you need to find $\frac{1}{4}$ then x3.
Year 3	There are 30 days in September, April, June and November.
Year 4	$\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{4}{8}$, $\frac{8}{16}$ are equivalent to $\frac{1}{2}$.
Year 5	To calculate the area of a composite shape like a capital L, divide into 2 rectangles, calculate the area of each and add them together.
