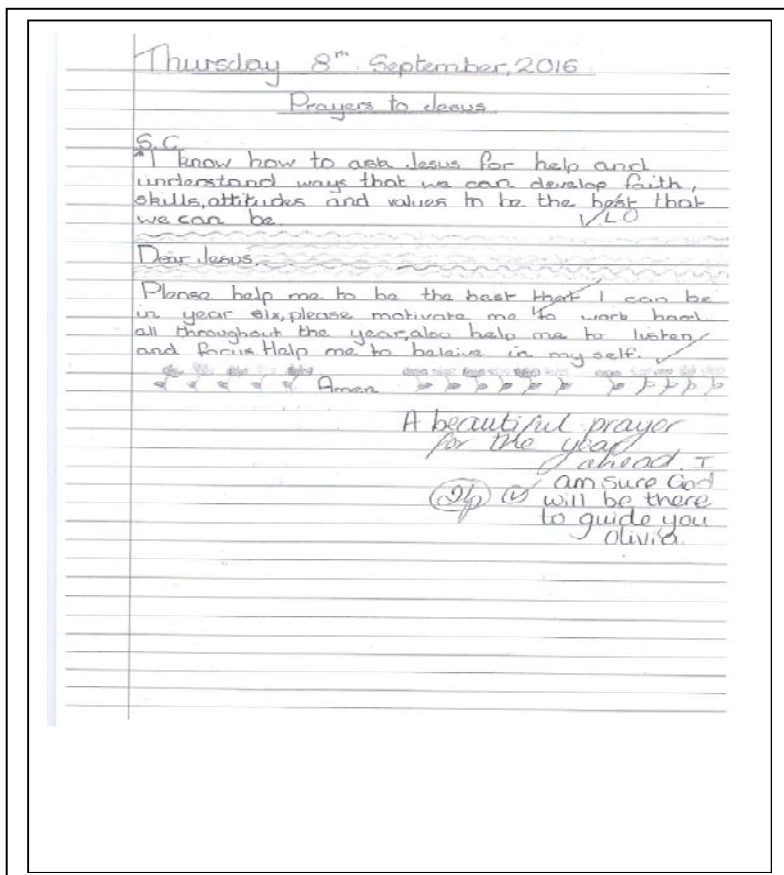

## Fact of the Week

| Rec'n         | There are two days that make up the weekend.                                |
|---------------|---|
| <b>Year 1</b> | A cube has 6 square faces   |
| <b>Year 2</b> | $23 = 2 \text{ tens and } 3 \text{ units}$                                  |
| <b>Year 3</b> | Addition is the inverse of subtraction                                      |
| <b>Year 4</b> | We can use the inverse operation to help us check our calculations.         |
| <b>Year 5</b> | $1426 = 1000 + 400 + 20 + 6$  |
| <b>Year 6</b> | A square number is a number multiplied by itself, e.g. $12 \times 12 = 144$ |
