Well done for being the best class. Keep aiming for those high percentages every week.

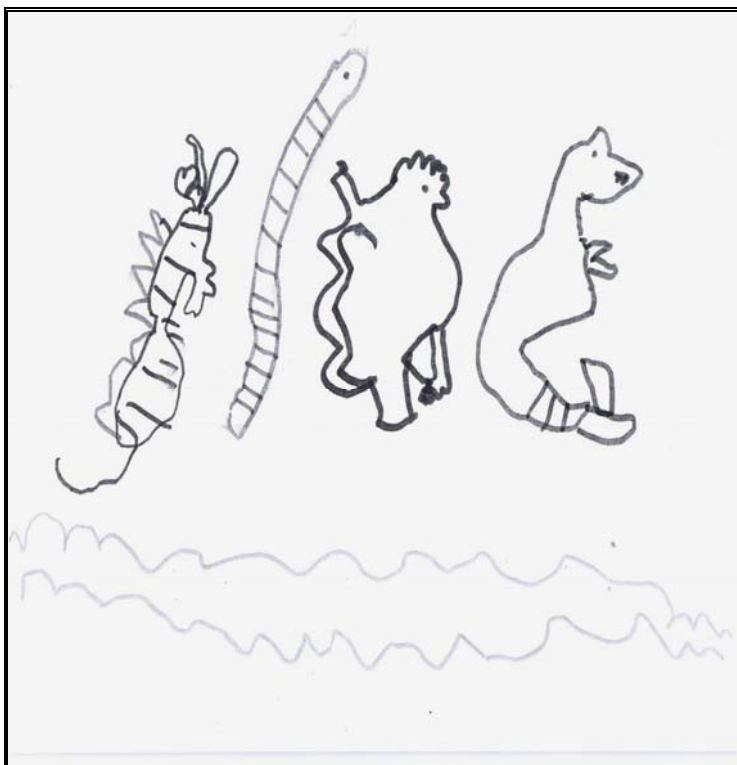
Fact of the Week

Rec'n	A rectangle has four sides: two short and two long.
Year 1	There is less light and more dark on Winter days.
Year 2	We can 'bridge 10' for addition.
Year 3	When multiplying a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number: partition the 2-digit number into 10s and units.
Year 4	We can use factors to help us with multiplication. eg $14 \times 5 =$ can be calculated as $5 \times (2 \times 7) =$
Year 5	When you square a number, you multiply it by itself.
Year 6	1kg = 2.2 lbs

SAFEGUARDING: Think safe, be safe



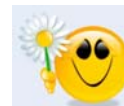
Make sure your bicycle is safe to ride - your brakes and tyres should be working well. Make sure your front and back lights work well and your back reflector is clean.
