In general, we are doing well.

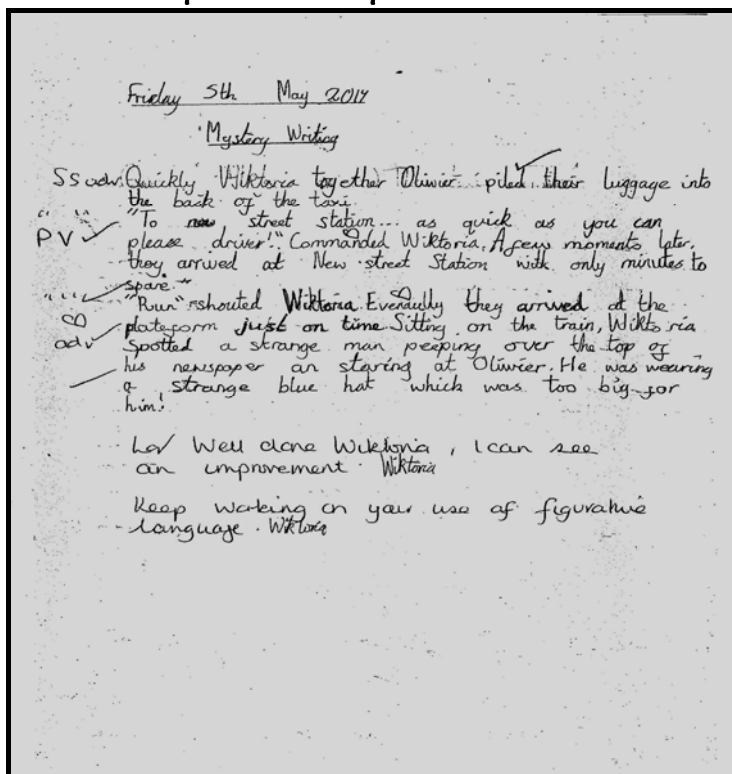
