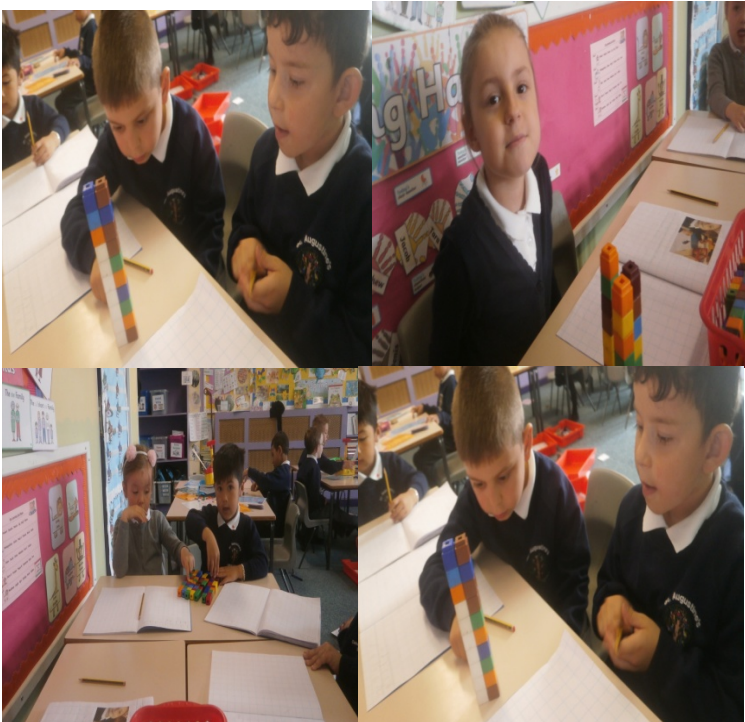

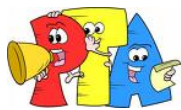


## SCHOOL NEWS
