Fact of the Week

Rec	There are 30 days in November.
Year 1	We are in the season of Autumn.
Year 2	349 - there are 3 hundreds, 4 tens and 9 units in this number: $300 + 40 + 9$.
Year 3	We can identify parallel and perpendicular lines.
Year 4	We can use estimation and the inverse operation to check our calculations.
Year 5	Division is the inverse of multiplication: $30 \div 5 = 6$, $6 \times 5 = 30$.
Year 6	There are 1.6km in a mile \rightarrow 5 miles = 8km.

In the Anointing of the sick, the priest anoints the poorly or elderly with the oil of Christ. It's used when somebody is poorly. It is blessed by the Bishop at the Christ Mass during Holy Week. If the person's dying they'll be offered Holy Communion.
