## Fact of the Week

Rec	A triangle has three sides.
Year 1	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> are ordinal numbers.
Year 2	We can add 11 by adding 10 and 1 more. We can add 9 by adding 10 and taking away 1.
