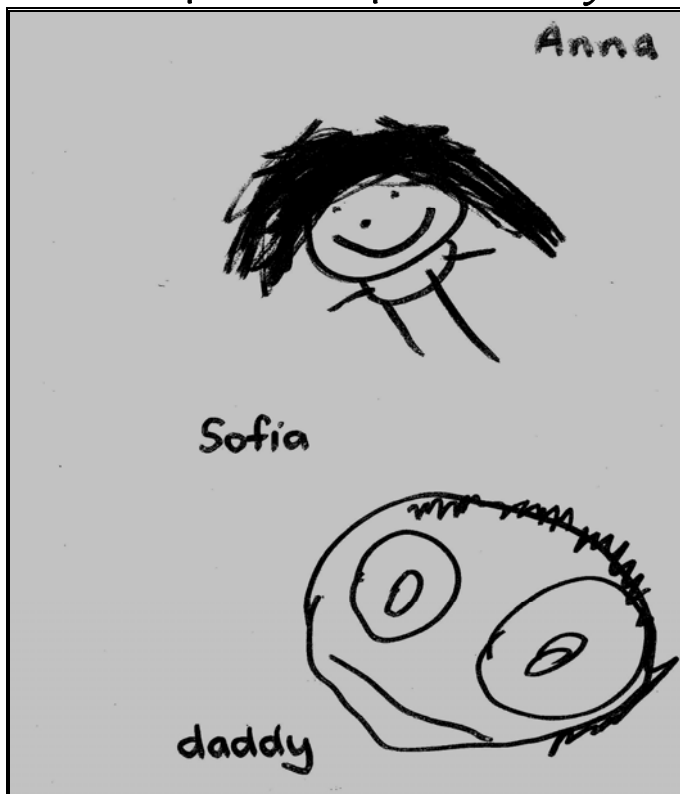

Rec	There are 4 sides and 4 corners on a square.

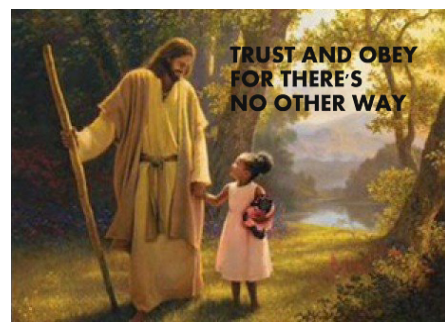


Children in Nursery have drawn lovely pictures.

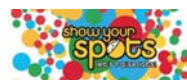
SCHOOL NEWS
