Make sure you set off early to be on time for the start of the school day.

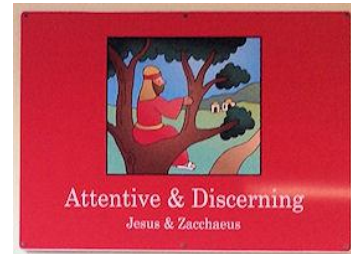
