


e-SAFETY

REMEMBER THE ONLINE RULES:

- S SAFE** - Keep safe by being careful not to give out personal information - such as your full name, email address, phone number, home address, photos or school name - to people you are chatting with online.
- M MEETING** - Meeting someone you have only been in touch with online can be dangerous. Only meet up with your parent or carer.
- A ACCEPTING** - Don't accept anything, like messages or pictures from, strangers or people you don't know. Don't give out your name or school name.
- R RELIABLE** - Information you find on the internet may not be true. An online writer may be lying about who they are.
- T TELL** - Tell your parent, carer or a trusted adult if someone is bothering you or if you are worried about anything. If you or someone you know is being bullied online, you can report online abuse to the police at www.thinkuknow.co.uk


