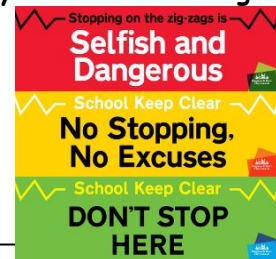
Thank you for your positive response to our messages about driving and parking. Unfortunately, there are still a few parents who are blocking the driveways or stopping in inconvenient places.
