**Your poster must show how important it is to:**

- † **WASH HANDS:** keep washing your hands regularly for 20 seconds
- † **COVER FACE:** wear a face covering in enclosed spaces.
- † **MAKE A SPACE:** stay at least 2 metres apart or 1 metre with a face covering/other precautions
- † **SOCIALISE SENSIBLY:** you cannot socialise with anybody outside of your household or support bubble in any indoor setting, whether at home or in a public place
- † **ATTEND SCHOOL:** schools will remain open and it is really important that everyone respects the rules on how to keep people safe
