All medical absences must be supported by evidence from the GP/dentist/hospital etc.

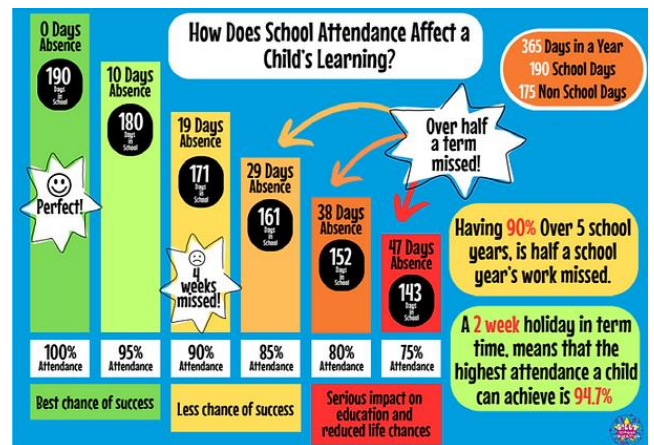

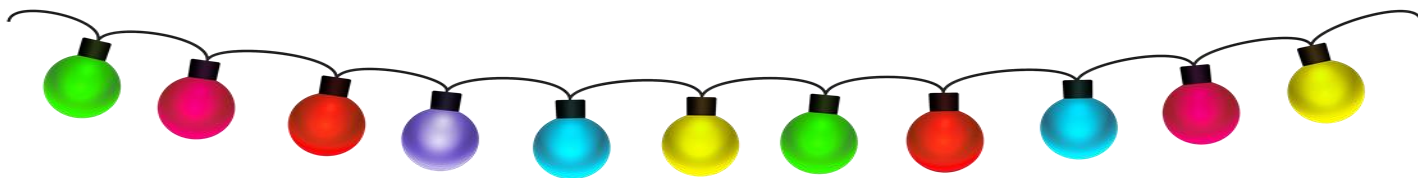
