### SAFER INTERNET DAY

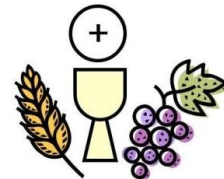
We all learned so much about how to avoid scams when using the internet.

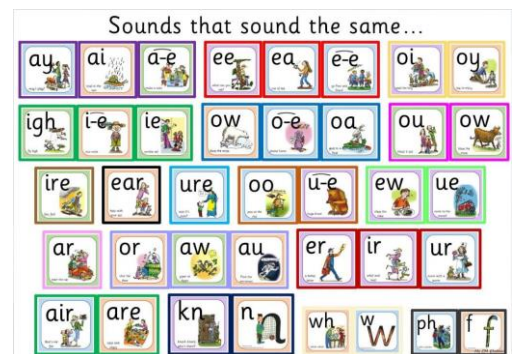
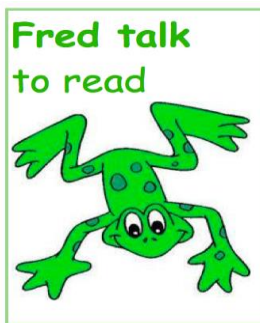
